DAY 01: ARRIVAL AT AMSTERDAM

When you arrive at Airport, the driver or agent will be waiting to take you to the hotel. You will have free time to explore the city on your own, depending on the time the flight lands.

Amsterdam is a city and port in the western Netherlands that is connected to the North Sea by the Ijsselmeer. It serves as the Netherlands' capital and major economic and financial hub. Amsterdam is well-known among the large number of tourists who come here each year for its historical landmarks, outstanding art collections, and the distinct colour and taste of its ancient neighbourhoods that have been so carefully kept. Visitors to the city, however, also witness a crowded metropolis plagued by air pollution, heavy traffic, and a housing crisis.

Palace of Versailles is one of the most opulent and beautiful palaces in the world and was the principle residence of French royalty till the French revolution. Built in 1682, the palace houses the fabulous hall of mirrors, royal apartments, beautiful paintings and magnificent sculptures. The vast Gardens of Versailles that span the royal estate consists of manicured lawns and sculptured fountains. The 'Treaty of Versailles' that marked the end of World War 1 was also signed here.



La Vellee village is home to more than 110 boutiques from the world's leading designers. It is part of 11 global shopping destinations that offer leading luxury brands at one places and discounted prices. Those uninterested in shopping can enjoy the culinary experience offered by numerous restaurants and coffee shops present in the village.

After breakfast, transfer to Paris railway station to board a high-speed train to Nice.

Nice is a beautiful city located on the coast of Mediterranean sea at the base of the French Alps, whose pleasant climate attracted the European aristocracy and rich merchants from as early as 18th century. It is popularly called 'Nice La Belle' which means Nice the beautiful as it's stunning beaches and old-world opulance bewitches anyone who visits this city.

DAY 08: EZE VILLAGE AND MONACO SIGHTSEEING TOUR

After breakfast, we will transfer to one of the smallest and also one of the richest country in the world – Monaco. Enroute we will visit a **perfume factory at Eze. Eze** is a popular medieval French village which is famous for its spectacular views and authentic perfumeries. At the perfume factory in Eze, specialists will explain to you how perfumes are made. Learn how the special ingredients are extracted from nature and the specialised machinery convert them into exotic fragrances.

After the factory tour, we will proceed to **Monaco**. With a population of just 40,000 residents. Monaco is one of the most expensive and wealthiest countries in the world with 30% of its population deemed millionaires. The country changed its financial fortune by opening the Monte Carlo Casino which attracted the rich from all over Europe. Today it is a major banking centre.

We will start our tour of Monaco by witnessing the **changing of the guards ceremony** at the Palace of Monaco. The ceremony which remains unchanged for the last 100 years,











involves soldier marching past in perfect co-ordination at the main entrance of the palace complex.

Next we will visit the **Cathedrale Notre-Dame-Immaculee**, a beautiful roman catholic church where members of the royal family are buried after their death. Also try your luck at one of the most famous casinos in the world - Monte Carlo. Built in the 19th century, it is not only an entertainment hub but also an architectural marvel. Lastly, enjoy the drive on the track where the famous Monaco Grand Prix is held.

Return to Nice and overnight stay at hotel.

DAY 10: MILAN CITY TOUR













Today, we will proceed for a city tour of Milan on a Hop-On Hop-Off bus. You can begin the tour with a visit to the **Church of Santa Maria delle Grazie** to marvel at one of the most recognisable paintings in the world - The Last Supper by Leonardo Di Vinci. The spellbinding mural depicts the scene of the dinner when Jesus predicts that one of his 12 Apostles (disciples) would betray him. After being awed by the painting, proceed to the Duomo di Milano. One of the largest and most beautiful churches in the world, it is decorated with surreal life-like sculptures and colourful stained windows built by some of the greatest artists in the world. Here you can also check out the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II, the oldest shopping arcade in Italy which houses exclusive high-end boutiques and stores of famous luxury brands such as Louis Vuitton, Gucci and Prada.

DAY 11: TRANSFER TO FLORENCE AND WALKING TOUR











After breakfast, we will check out from the hotel and transfer to Naples Train Station. From Naples, we will catch a train to the city of Florence.

During Medieval times, Florence was one of the wealthiest cities in the world and was at the centre of arts and culture. Today, Florence occupies a place in the hearts of art aficionados and is the capital of the beautiful Tuscany region of Italy. The city features artworks by the most notable personalities such as Leonardo Da Vinci, Michelangelo, Dante and Botticelli. Financially backed by the powerful Medici family of Florence, these greats gave birth to the Renaissance movement that spread throughout the world.

After freshening up at the hotel. Head out for a walking tour of the lively Historic centre of Florence, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Here, at Piazza del Duomo, you shall witness the beauty of the majestic Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore, the Baptistry, Campanile of Giotto and several others notable buildings. The architecture of these buildings, their surrounding sculptures and their artwork are products of 600 years of profound artistic activity in the region in the 15th and 16th century. Marvel at the most famous sculpture in the world, that of **David by Michelangelo** at Gallerie Dell'Academia. Overnight stay at the hotel in Florence.

SEGV'S RECOMMENDATION - Originally built as an office complex for the powerful Medici family of Florence, the private viewing gallery on the top floor expanded to occupy the whole building which is now called the **Uffizi Gallery**, the world's largest collection of Renaissance art. For any art lover, this place is a must visit, featuring priceless artwork from some of the greatest artists of all time.

DAY 12: PISA, SIENA AND SAN GIMIGNANO TOUR WITH WINE TASTING

After breakfast at the hotel, we will proceed for a tour of the beautiful Tuscany region.

Begin the tour with a visit to the the medieval gem of **Siena**. Pass through the picturesque streets and explore main piazza of the city - Piazza del Campo. Other sights include the beautiful Siena Cathedral and Torre del Mangia.











Next, drive about one hour through the rolling hills of Tuscany to reach a lovely winery in the countryside outside of San Gimignano. Indulge in a wine tasting of high-level wines accompanied by a delicious typical Tuscan meal with meat and cheese plate, pasta, and dessert.



Then drive onwards to the hilltop town of **San Gimignano**. Sometimes called a medieval Manhattan, San Gimignano is visible from close and far, with its unmistakable medieval "skyscrapers." there are still thirteen towers intact in this perfectly preserved hilltop town. Viist the main square - Piazza della Cisterna, where you can find the Cathedral, **Duomo**, and lovely architecture.

Finally, visit the medieval city of Pisa. Here we will marvel at the iconic Leaning Tower of Pisa which is renowned world over for its outrageous slant. Also located in the same complex, the **cathedral** and **cemetery** are architectural marvels that play with white marbles and colourful mosaics. The baptistry, also located nearby, is famous for its amazing acoustic design which allowed the bishop to communicate with the people without using a mike.

Cinque Terre Trip - Take a day excursion from Florence to the stunning Cinque Terre to explore the Italian Riviera. From the beaches of Monterosso to the quaint towns of Riomaggiore, travel to each fishing village under the guidance of a tour guide by bus, train, and boat. Swim in the clear waters before upgrading to a typical Italian meal. Take in all the personality of this UNESCO-listed area before returning to Florence.

Wine Tasting Tour- the various delights of Tuscany's wine region. Travel past cypress trees, vineyards, and olive gardens while on scenic hillside roads. Visit two renowned wineries in the renowned Chianti Classico region, have a cellar tour, and see how wine is made the old-fashioned way. Try a variety of wines, olive oils, and Tuscan delicacies like bruschetta and fresh cheeses.

Venice day trip- On a private day excursion leaving from Florence, explore the stunning bridges and canals of Venice. On a private walking tour, pass by St. Mark's Square, the iconic Ducal Palace, and the Bridge of Sighs while learning about the fascinating history of the city. Then take advantage of your free time to explore on your own by going to the islands of Murano and Burano or by paying for a beautiful gondola ride. The evening transfer return to Florence completes this customizable vacation.

DAY 14: TRANSFER TO ROME AND VATICAN CITY TOUR

Tranfer to Rome and proceed to your city centre hotel in **Rome** for check-in.

The capital of the Great Roman Empire and home to the Roman Catholic Church, Rome has been at the centre of European politics and Christianity since antiquity. After the fall of the Roman empire due to corruption and overindulgence, the city eventually fell into despair and ruin until the city's rebirth as a centre for awe-inspiring art and culture, and delicious cuisine. Today, Rome is one of the most visited city in the world, where tourists come from all over the world to explore its history and culture and fell in love with this 'eternal city'.











After freshening-up at the hotel, we will proceed for a tour of the world's smallest country, Vatican City.

Home to the Pope, **Vatican City** is an independent country with a population of just 800 people located within the city of Rome. We will start the sightseeing tour of the Vatican with a visit to St Peter's Square. This beautiful space with glorious fountains and Egyptian Obelisks is the place where people gather every Wednesday to see the pope and seek his blessings. Next we will visit St Peter's Basilica. Built on the same spot where St Peter was buried, the basilica is a awe-inspiring church with breath-taking beauty enshrined in its religious sculptures built by famous artists such as Michelangelo.

DAY 15: ROME CITY TOUR

After breakfast at the hotel, we will proceed for a city tour of Rome to see some of Rome's best-preserved ancient sites.

We will start the city tour with a visit to the **Colosseum**, one of the new seven wonders of the world. With a seating capacity of 80,000 spectators, it was the largest amphitheatre in the world at the time of its construction in 72 AD. Its arena was used for gladiator fights, animal hunting, re-enactments of famous battles and mythological plays. After the tour of Colosseum, we will take a tour of the **Roman Forum**, an iconic plaza at the hub of daily life in ancient Rome. Important public affairs such as elections and public speeches were onducted at the Roman Forum, which is dotted with ruins of the Senate House, Temple of Saturn and more.

Later proceed to Trevi fountain. Made in Baroque style using Travertine Stone, it is believed that wishes come true for all those who make a wish at the fountain and throw a coin. We will also visit the **Pantheon**, an iconic temple built for Roman Gods in 126 A.D., it was later consecrated as a Christina Church. The tour shall end at Piazza Navona, a bustling square with beautiful fountains, street artists and painters.
