DAY 01: Arrive In Melbourne

On arrival at Melbourne Airport, you will be met by our local representative in Australia for a brief meet and greet. Later, proceed to your city centre hotel in Melbourne for checkin.

Declared capital of the British colony of Victoria in 1851, **Melbourne** is today recognized as one of the most livable cities in the world. A prominent financial center and Australia's cultural capital, much of the city's growth and wealth is attributed to the gold rush that happened in Victoria in the 1850s. The residents refer to themselves as 'Melburnians' and are extremely fond of sports and love to leisure around local artisan cafes which sell freshly brewed coffee.

SEGV'S RECOMMENDATION - Melbourne star is an iconic observation wheel situated in Melbourne's lively waterfront precinct. With a height of 120m, the 360 degree view from the passenger pods is stunning. The background commentary informs the visitors about the history and significance of important landmarks of the city. During the evening, thousands of LEDs transform the observation wheel into a sparkling kaleidoscope of colours.

DAY 02: Melbourne City Tour And Penguin Parade At Phillip Island

After breakfast, we will proceed for a sight-seeing tour of Melbourne.

We will begin the sight-seeing tour with a panaromic city tour of Melbourne which will take you to the most popular attractions in the city including the Parliament House, Queen Victoria Market and Princess theatre. The tour ends at Federation square which is an open air venue built over a railway junction that is surrounded by world class art galleries and museums. Also visit the iconic Melbourne Cricket Ground where we can book for you a behind the scenes tour of the famous MCG lounge and changing rooms.















In the evening, we will proceed to Philips Island to see the native Australian wildlife. At Philips Island, you get to watch little penguins return to their burrows on the sand shore during sunset, after completing their marine adventure for the day.

DAY 03: Great Ocean Road Tour From Melbourne

After breakfast at the hotel, proceed for a full day tour of the Great Ocean Road.

The world's largest war memorial, the **Great Ocean Road** is a scenic drive hugging the coast line and provides fantastic views of the Antarctic Ocean and the bizarrely shaped limestone cliffs. During the scenic drive, we shall first stop at the most famous attraction on Great Ocean Road 12 apostles, where beautiful limestone structures formed due to the destructive force of wind and water stand tall at sea. Next we will travel to Shipwreck **coast**, also called Loch Ard Gorge, named after a ship by the same name that crash landed here with just two survivors who managed to tell the tale. Finally, enjoy watching the surfers tackle the waves at one of the best surfing destinations, **Bells Beach**.

DAY 04: Yarra Valley Gourmet Tour With Wine Tasting

After breakfast at the hotel, we will proceed for a full-day ecotour departing from Melbourne, savour a genuine taste of the **Yarra Valley**. As you journey across the mix of vineyards and farmlands, stop with neighbourhood farmers, family-run wineries, and artisan producers. Along the way, stop at Balgownie Estate to indulge in wine tasting, the Yarra Valley Chocolaterie to sample delectable handmade chocolates, and Rochford Winery to have a sumptuous lunch.

DAY 05: Free Day For Leisure

This day is free for your leisure. You can opt to explore and seek any of the following activities:

The **Melbourne Cricket Ground (MCG) tour** is a must-do for sports enthusiasts who are interested in learning more about Australia's sporting heritage. To enhance your experience, combine the tour of the stadium's top-notch amenities with the optional entrance to the Australian Sports Museum.

The 974-foot (274-meter) Eureka Tower's **Eureka Skydeck** 88, a 360-degree viewing platform, is a defining experience in Melbourne. The Edge, a cantilevered glass cube that slides out from the skyscraper and suspends you over the city streets, is available for the courageous. A green-screen set-up called Vertigo imitates falling from a building.

DAY 06: Transfer To Uluru

After breakfast at the hotel, we will transfer to Uluru by flight and immerse ourselves in the unique landscapes of the Red Centre

The gigantic sandstone monolith Uluru, also known as Ayers Rock, is located in the arid "Red Centre" of the Northern Territory. The closest major city is 450 kilometres distant, at Alice Springs. Indigenous Australians revere Uluru, which is believed to have formed some 550 million years ago. The 36 red-rock domes of the Kata Tjuta formation are located within Uluru-Kata Tjuta National Park.

Overnight stay at the hotel in Uluru.

DAY 07: Field Of Light Art Installation

After breakfast at the hotel, we will proceed to witness the magical sunrise or sunset at Uluru and Kata Tjuta.

Later, Visit the Field of Light art installation by Bruce Munro. Bruce Munro, a British artist, designed a massive site-specific light installation called The Field of Light. The sculpture gradually changes hue, producing a field of light that shimmers. You can see the brilliant violet, ochre, blue, and white tones of the desert on the moving coloured spheres. The spheres are connected by optical fibre, which glows as night falls, and the exhibition is entirely powered by solar energy.

DAY 08: Explore Kings Canyon

After breakfast at the hotel, we will proceed to explore the Kings Canyon and hike through its stunning sandstone walls.

The largest preserved grove of sequoia trees in the world can be found in Kings Canyon National Park, which has a landscape resembling Yosemite Valley. John Muir once eferred to Kings Canyon National Park as "a rival to Yosemite" due to its deep valleys, tall trees, and unusual rock outcroppings.

Overnight stay at the hotel in Uluru.

DAY 09: Transfer To Cairns

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and transfer to Queenstown airport to catch a flight to Cairns.



Originally a mangrove swamp home to Aboriginal Australian tribes, Cairns has evolved into a world famous tourist town, serving as the gateway to two UNESCO world heritage sites - The Great Barrier Reef and Wet Tropics. A favourite destination for adrenaline junkies, you can enjoy fantastic scuba diving experience here.

DAY 10: Excursion To Kuranda Rainforest

After breakfast at the hotel, we will proceed for a full day tour of Kuranda rainforest which is a part of Wet Tropics of Queensland. Wet Tropics are one of the oldest continuously existing rainforest in the world, that has been in existence since 550 Million years ago, preceding even the dinosaurs. Both the koalas and Kangaroos trace their origin to this region.

We will start the action-packed tour with a spectacular journey on the **Skyrail Rainforest** Cableway that flies above the forests canopy giving magnificent views of the surroundings. Next, hop on to an amphibious vehicle from world war II called 'Army **Duck**' that takes you on a journey of exploration through the stunning rainforest both over land and water. Next learn about the traditions and culture of the aboriginal people of Australia who have been living in these forests since ages. Watch a live folk-dance performance at **Rainforestation Nature Park** by traditionally-clothed forest dwellers with fabulous body-tattoos. Also learn how to throw weapons used by the Pamagirri Aboriginal people such as boomerang and spear. Kids can also spend a fun time playing with Koalas, Kangaroos, crocodiles and Lizards at The Koala and Wildlife Park. Finally return to Cairns city.

DAY 11: Explore The Great Barrier Reef

After breakfast at the hotel, we will take a Catamaran Cruise To Green Island, The Great Barrier Reef, the largest coral system in the world.

A combination of 2500 coral reefs and 900 islands of various sizes, The Great Barrier **Reef** is the only living structure on Earth that is visible from space. The rich and complex natural ecosystem below the ocean surface comprising of naturally shaped corals and beautiful fishes boast of splendid colours, unique species and spell-binding scenery. Here you can explore the underwater world either by glass bottom boat or snorkelling. Those who wouldn't like to get wet won't miss out as they can go on a underwater tour in a semisubmersible. You can also chose to do a helicopter tour to get a magnificent view of the magnificent Green Islands. The Great barrier Reef is also the world's best spot for scuba diving – so diving enthusiasts can enjoy an out-worldly scuba diving experience here.

DAY 12: Transfer To Gold Coast

Gold Coast is a famous coastal city located on Australia's Eastern Coast. Originally named "South Coast" due to its proximity to Brisbane, the state's capital, it quickly garnered the label "Gold Coast" because of the insane rise in prices of real estate. Today, it is a world-class tourist destination welcoming travelers to its surfer-ready beaches and fantastic theme parks. The city is also home to Australia's film industry and hosted the Commonwealth Games in 2018.

The day is free for you to explore Gold Coast on your own. Spend some time by the beach or visit the SkyPoint Observation Deck located on 77th and 78th floor of Q1 Building to enjoy stunning views of the city.
