DAY 01: ARRIVE IN TOKYO

It had its humble beginnings as a fishing village called Edo, which became an important political centre in 1 7th century and by the time the emperor shifted his imperial capital from Kyoto to Tokyo in 19th century, it was already the most populous city in the world. Today Tokyo is famous for its busy streets, anime inspired markets and large video game parlours.

DAY 02: TOKYO SIGHTSEEING TOUR

Vist the **Hie Shrine**, renowned for its captivating red Torii gates. Take in the spiritual ambiance and appreciate the unique beauty of this historical site. Your day promises a blend of cultural exploration, panoramic views, and delightful culinary experiences in the heart of Tokyo.



Later, visit the world-renowned **Arashiyama Bamboo Forest in Kyoto.** Wander through this enchanting natural wonder, where dense green bamboo stalks create a mesmerizing labyrinth that seems to stretch endlessly in every direction. After breakfast at the hotel, head to the station to catch the **KTX train** bound for **Busan**.







DAY 10: VISIT GAMCHEON CULTURE VILLAGE AND TRANSFER TO SEOUL










