DAY 01: ARRIVE IN ROME AND VATICAN CITY TOUR

On arrival at Leonardo da Vinci International Airport, you will be met by our local representative in Italy for a brief meet and greet. Later, proceed to your city centre hotel in Rome for check-in.

The capital of the Great Roman Empire and home to the Roman Catholic Church, Rome has been at the centre of European politics and Christianity since antiquity. After the fall of the Roman empire due to corruption and overindulgence, the city eventually fell into despair and ruin until the city's rebirth as a centre for awe-inspiring art and culture, and delicious cuisine. Today, Rome is one of the most visited city in the world, where tourists come from all over the world to explore its history and culture and fell in love with this 'eternal city'.



After freshening-up at the hotel, we will proceed for a tour of the world's smallest country, Vatican City.

Home to the Pope, Vatican City is an independent country with a population of just 800 people located within the city of Rome. We will start the sightseeing tour of the Vatican with a visit to St Peter's Square. This beautiful space with glorious fountains and Egyptian Obelisks is the place where people gather every Wednesday to see the pope and seek his blessings. Next we will visit St Peter's Basilica. Built on the same spot where St Peter was buried, the basilica is a awe-inspiring church with breath-taking beauty enshrined in its religious sculptures built by famous artists such as Michelangelo.

DAY 02: ROME CITY TOUR

After breakfast at the hotel, we will proceed for a city tour of Rome to see some of Rome's best-preserved ancient sites.

We will start the city tour with a visit to the Colosseum, one of the new seven wonders of the world. With a seating capacity of 80,000 spectators, it was the largest amphitheater in the world at the time of its construction in 72 AD. Its arena was used for gladiator fights, animal hunting, re-enactment's of famous battles and mythological plays. After





the tour of Colosseum, we will take a tour of the Roman Forum, an iconic plaza at the hub of daily life in ancient Rome. Important public affairs such as elections and public speeches were conducted at the Roman Forum, which is dotted with ruins of the Senate



House, Temple of Saturn and more.

Later proceed to Trevi fountain. Made in Baroque style using Travertine Stone, it is believed that wishes come true for all those who make a wish at the fountain and throw a coin. We will also visit the Pantheon, an iconic temple built for Roman Gods in 126 A.D., it was later consecrated as a Christina Church. The tour shall end at Piazza Navona, a bustling square with beautiful fountains, street artists and painters.

DAY: 03 FULL DAY POMPEII & MT VESUVIUS TOUR

After breakfast at the hotel, we will proceed for a full day Mount Vesuvius tour & Pompeii tour from Rome.

Later proceed for a guided tour from Rome to the iconic Mt. Vesuvius, the volcano that famously destroyed Pompeii. Enjoy a picturesque drive, hike to the crater's edge, and gain insights into the volcano's history from an expert guide.

Later enjoy a guided walking tour of the archaeological site of Pompeii introduces you to the history and remnants of the ancient Roman city, which was buried





in volcanic ash after the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79 AD.

You'll learn how the residents were frozen in time, unaware of the danger, and see ruins



such as the Forum, Thermal Baths, and preserved frescoes.

DAY 04: DAY AT LEISURE IN ROME

After breakfast at the hotel, rest of the day is free for you to explore Rome on own.

You can opt for the following experiences or request us for more personalized experiential tours that are suitable to your liking –

1. Take a guided tour of Montepulciano and treat yourself to a mouthwatering threecourse meal that includes a memorable Italian wine tasting. In Rome, a cozy, airconditioned coach will come to pick you up. Your knowledgeable tour guide will address overview of Tuscany's rich cultural heritage as you journey toward the gently undulating hills. Take a strolling tour of Montepulciano, a hill town, first. See remains dating back before Rome and an old, functional wine cellar. Proceed





to San Biagio, a 16th-century Renaissance church featuring beautiful interior decorations and a travertine front that lets in plenty of natural light. A great meal in Tuscany is just a short drive away. In the wine cellar of a real vineyard farmhouse, have a three-course meal paired with wines, including the famed Brunello di Montalcino and others from the vineyard itself. Here you can either purchase a memento of Tuscan wine or wait for Pienza, the last destination. While your tour guide will share insights, you have your own time. Find the ideal photo spot, shop for wines, balsamic vinegar, pecorino cheese, and other regional specialties, or just stroll about the streets like a native. At last, arrive back in Rome.
